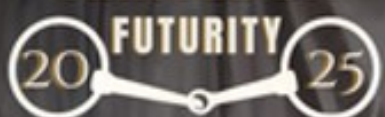

Media Policy

Visitors, spectators, and exhibitors at ARCHA Events are permitted to take photographs and record video for personal use only. Visitors, spectators, and exhibitors are strictly prohibited from taking photographs and video for commercial distribution. This policy applies to, but not limited to, competition arenas; warm up arenas; barn and stall areas; and cattle facilities. For media questions please contact Show Management.

Compulsory Stable Bond - \$90 per stable (refundable upon leaving the stable cleaned of all bedding, twine/string etc)

Please note all bedding must be removed and horse box cleaned on departure of your event to receive your bond back.

All cancellations must be processed through Nominate. Please contact Nominate directly to cancel your booking. No refunds will be considered once the first booking day, or first event day (whichever occurs first) has been reached.

Horse stalls are inspected the day of departure of event.

Camping

Camping is must be filled using the Eastern side of the facility as a priority. No camping is permitted on the Competition Grounds/ Dressage area

Powered Site - \$42 per site, per night (horses cannot be yarded in the powered area, you must book either a stable or an unpowered site for horses)

Un-Powered Site - \$22 per site, per night

Dogs & Pets

Dogs are welcome at White Park, however, must be on a leash within the Indoor arena area and Camp draft arena area. For their safety, please consider leaving dogs at home or making appropriate plans for their care and comfort onsite.

Animal Welfare

The Australian Reined Cow Horse Association takes seriously the welfare of the equine partners and the cattle that allow for participation in our events. Animal use is deeply ingrained in our society, benefiting the health of people, supporting commerce, and enhancing our enjoyment of life. ARCHA acknowledges the valuable role of these animal partners in our lives, in history and in horse shows, and is committed to providing a proper environment for them in competition, in transport and at rest, and to providing humane guidelines for care and treatment of both horses and cattle. Inhumane treatment of the equine partners we ride or the cattle vital to our competition is not acceptable.

Payment Policy

All entries must be accompanied by full payment prior to the start of the show. To receive pay-outs please ensure the correct bank account details are entered in the Entry form.

Late Entries & Fees

Late entries will be accepted until 4pm the day before the class begins and will be assigned first position on the draw (rein and fence work) or last position in the draw (herd work). Late fees will be charged to any entry received after the due date.

Terms & Conditions

All competitors & owners must hold a valid ARCHA Membership. Medical Forms and Waivers are to be completed as part of your entries. Only members of ARCHA are permitted to ride on the grounds for the duration of the event.

Competitors shall not talk to the judge beyond normal greetings during the show as per NRCHA rule 14.1.6.

No smoking in the main arena grandstand. Please use designated smoking areas.

The Horses' age will be recognised as per the 1st of August of each year. For example, a Horse that was 4 years old as of the 1st of August 2022 will be recognised as a 4-year-old for this event

All Horses displayed by Non-Pro Members must be owned by the Non-Pro exhibiting the Horse. If the Horse is registered with an organisation, such as AQHA, ASHS, AAA, APHA, etc, the Horse exhibited must be registered in the name of the Non-Pro Member exhibiting the Horse, or a recognised Family Member, in accordance with the NRCHA rule 2.4.

If you do not have a current and valid Non-Pro Declaration on File, a Member of the Organising Team will be in contact to complete your Non-Pro Declaration and email it to ARCHA prior to the Show.

Failure to complete a Non-Pro Declaration will result in either competitor's entry being moved into an eligible (Open) class, or a complete scratch from all ineligible classes entered. No refunds will be given in this scenario.

Any accident, injury, concern, complaint, or grievance is to be reported to the Show Manager, Competitors Representative or Board Member.

Protests or complaints must be filed in writing with the show office or Board of Directors as per NRCHA rule 14.3.1

Abuse of any form towards members, competitors, show management or staff will not be tolerated and may result in disciplinary action.

Refund Policy

Scratches must be in writing and received in the show office. • Scratches made on or before the due date will not be charged • Show entrants scratching, for any reason, after close of entries, will be required to produce a vet certificate and will still incur cattle charges and applicable fees.

Pay-outs

The pay-outs for all horse show classes will follow NRCHA rule 10.5.1.
